AMC used manufacturer's parts they didn't use their own. The 360-ci was built by Mopar and the 390-ci was built by Ford. But did you know that AMC used Chrysler built transmissions, or Ford built carb... The AMC Rebel (known as the Rambler Rebel in 1967) is a mid-sized car produced by American Motors Corporation (AMC) from 1967 to 1970. It replaced the Rambler Classic. The Rebel was replaced by the similar AMC Matador for the 1971 model year. The Rebel was positioned as the high-volume seller in the independent automaker's line of models.
