

Download Poems With Figurative Language

Elementary

Included in this product are 31 figurative language task cards. Some of the cards contain simpler examples of figurative language. 18 of cards contain excerpts from poems and famous literature (ex. Pride and Prejudice, The Heart of Darkness, poems by Emily Dickinson and William Wordsworth.)“Figurative Language” helps students learn about using specific elements of literature. The song covers personification, alliteration, assonance, hyperbole, onomatopoeia, metaphors, and similes, and gives figurative language examples by teaching through music, rhyme, and memorization. Irony. In 'The Road Not Taken', we could also interpret a sense of irony, specifically, verbal irony. Verbal irony is an aspect of figurative language in which what the speaker says is the opposite ... This lesson examines Walt Whitman's famous ode to Abraham Lincoln, "O Captain! My Captain!" We discuss several examples of figurative language in the poem.
